Course: PADI Rescue Diver

Scuba divers describe the ***PADI Rescue Diver course*** as the most challenging, yet most rewarding course they've ever taken. Why? Because you learn to prevent and manage problems in the water, and become more confident in your skills as a diver, knowing that you can help others if needed. During the course, you learn to become a better buddy by practicing problem solving skills until they become second nature. Plus, the course is just fun – it's serious, but still allows for lots of laughter in between the focused learning.

You also need to have Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care (CPR and First Aid) training within the past 24 months. You can complete this training during the Rescue Diver course. Your instructor, Bill Ayaday, may also offer the PADI Emergency Oxygen Provider specialty diver course if required by the diver.

What will you learn?

The PADI Rescue Diver course prepares you to deal with dive emergencies, minor and major, using a variety of techniques. Through knowledge development and rescue exercises, you learn what to look for and how to respond. During rescue scenarios, you put into practice your knowledge and skills. Topics include:

- *Self-rescue ;*
- *Recognizing and managing stress in other divers ;*
- *Emergency management and equipment ;*
- *Rescuing panicked divers ;*
- *Rescuing unresponsive divers.*

How can you start learning now?

Register for Rescue Diver Online – PADI's eLearning option – to start now. You progress through five knowledge development sections using a web-based system that lets you learn at your own pace through an easy-to-use, interactive program. You also have

access to an online version of the Rescue Diver Manual for reference during and after the course.

If you prefer, you can choose to study with the Rescue Diver Manual and watch the Rescue Diver Video (a book and DVD package). Go to **Marina Blue** PADI Dive Center to enroll in the course, and start learning.

Your PADI Instructor will meet with you in Marina Blue, on April 25th, to schedule knowledge review sessions along with your rescue exercises and scenarios.
